## Part-Time Environmental Educator

**Summary:** As a Perkiomen Watershed Conservancy Environmental Educator, you will be part of an inclusive and collaborative team working to provide quality programs to learners of all ages. This position primarily supports the Education department during the school year, but can continue into other programs during the summer months. A successful candidate may come from a variety of professional backgrounds, but is energetic, curious, and inspired to teach, play and learn alongside children in the outdoors. We offer classes in watershed science, stream morphology, field, stream, and forest ecosystems, mammals, birds and more. A PWC Educator is also motivated to grow professionally as an instructor and staff member of a mission-driven, community-focused organization.

**About The Perkiomen Watershed Conservancy:** The Perkiomen Watershed Conservancy (PWC) is located in Schwenksville, PA in the heart of the Perkiomen Valley. The watershed stretches over 362 square miles, spanning 55 municipalities and 4 counties (Lehigh, Berks, Bucks, Montgomery) in southeastern PA. PWC's mission is to serve the people and communities of the Perkiomen Watershed by conserving and protecting land and water resources through commitment to and leadership in environmental education, watershed stewardship, and conservation programs. The Education department engages students of all ages, pre-K through adults, with a focus on school-aged children.

**Location:** This position is based out of PWC's office in Schwenksville, PA, but will also conduct programs in schools and at field locations throughout the watershed.

**Qualifications:** We seek individuals who are committed to providing today's youth with positive outdoor experiences. Required qualifications include the demonstrated ability to maintain a growth mindset and positive attitude in a work environment and a college degree or 2-years of relevant experience. Anyone applying for this role should be prepared to work outside in varying weather conditions on uneven terrain, including forest and field trails, gravel, and stream beds.

**Compensation/Benefits:** This role is a part-time, hourly position, with no more than 20 hours/week. Compensation is \$14.00/hour. Benefits include meaningful work in the outdoors, a flexible work schedule, and paid training in all aspects of programming. This position does not include health benefits.
